"Whose is that creepy-crawly?" is a book with hardboard pages specially aimed at children from the age of 3, helping them to discover the diminutive fauna that surround us, but which we rarely notice. Nevertheless, the protagonists of this story are charming, curious creatures, who we should know more about.

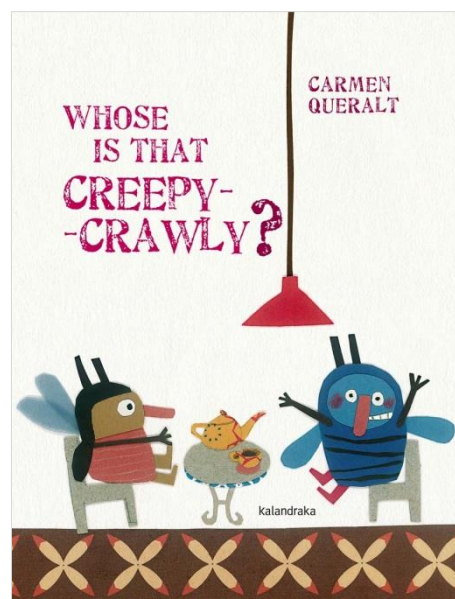
The book does not generalize about what creepy-crawlies look like. Readers will discover that they come in very different shapes and sizes. The text is short and simple, written in capitals to familiarize children with the alphabet, and making it easier to read.

This book focuses on describing and recognizing the characters of the story based on their physical appearance, using adjectives and qualities that distinguish between them.

Its has an attractive visual style, with illustrations made using collage and superimposed pencil strokes, basic designs, textures and contrasting colours. Children can personalize their books using a specially reserved space for their photo.
